Positive commands for people on first name terms.

1. Take the tú form of the present tense
2. Remove the final -s

Lavar = To wash

Los platos = The dishes

Wash the dishes now please

Lava los platos ahora, por favor

La basura = The rubbish

Sacar = To take out

Take out the rubbish please

Saca la basura ahora, por favor

Cerrar = To shut (stem changing verb)

La puerta = The door

Shut the door please

Cierra la puerta, por favor

Secar = To dry

El piso = The floor (or apartment)

Dry the floor please

Seca el piso, por favor

Positive commands for people in more formal situations, using usted.

1. Take the yo form of the present tense (there are some irregular yo forms, eg., tengo)
2. Drop the -o ending
3. Add a cris-cross ending
 - -a for -er and -ir verbs
 - -e for -ar verbs

Hablar = To speak

Yo form = Hablo

More = Más

Slowly = Lentamente or despacio

Speak more slowly please

Hable más despacio, por favor

To have = Tener

Yo form = Tengo

A nice journey = Un buen viaje

Have a nice journey

Tenga un buen viaje

Come = Venir

Yo form = Vengo

With me = Conmigo

Come with me please Sir

Venga conmigo por favor Señor

Volver = To come back

Yo form = Vuelvo

Soon = Pronto

Come back soon please Madam

Vuelva pronto por favor Señora

Take care = Cuidarse

Sit down = Sentarse (stem changing verb)

See you soon = Hasta pronto

Take care of yourself

Tú: Cuídate

Ud: Cuídese

Sit down

Tú: Siéntate

Ud: Siéntese
